

Play Park Safety Information

Parents and guardians are responsible for their children's behaviour and safety at all times whilst visiting the park, especially in the play areas and whilst using equipment.

Every care has been taken in the design and construction of the play park to create a safe environment. However, with any activity, the risk of an accident or injury still exists. If you find this risk unacceptable or are unhappy with the equipment, or the behaviour of other users, do not allow your children to enter the play area.

Entry to the play area is entirely at your own risk. The Tropical Butterfly House Ltd cannot be held liable for any loss, damage or injury, however caused.

Safety rules for all users

- Children and vulnerable adults must be supervised at all times by a responsible adult
- Food and drink should not be consumed whilst using any of the play equipment
- Play park equipment should only be used for its intended purpose
- Age and height safety restrictions, displayed on the play equipment, must be adhered to
- Extra care to be taken when using any of the climbing play equipment
- Do not run around the park or climb on walls, fences or gates
- Do not enter any unauthorised access areas
- Do not remove any play equipment from the areas in which they are in
- Behave kindly towards others
- Children must not throw sand or take sand out of sandpit areas
- Footwear must be worn at all times
- Only one person may use a slide at a time
- Children must not climb up or play in front of the slide exits
- Caution is to be taken when using any of the slides as these can become hot during warm weather and slippery in wet conditions
- Children must wash their hands after using the play equipment, especially before eating and drinking

Anyone displaying unsafe or unkind behaviour may be asked to leave the park.

Please report any problems, accidents, damaged or faulty play equipment immediately to the Duty Manager, so that we can maintain a safe play environment at all times. Thank you.
